Mayor Smith said historically the street committee would meet and then a meeting open for public comments would be held. Bob said he would look into it and meet with the committee.
11. Fiscal Officer Louallen said she wanted to update council on the quilt show. She said Norma and Mary Alice are going to be on channel 6 and the paper is doing an article on a couple of ladies and their quilts. They have book signings and are cleaning on the building now. If anyone would like to volunteer they can give me their number and Norma will let them know when they are going to be there working.
12. Solicitor Nixon said he did receive information on lodging tax and will draft an amendment to the tax ordinance for review at the next meeting.
13. Mayor Smith said the commissioner meeting will be next Tuesday at 11:00 a.m. He also said with no quorum tonight we need a special meeting to discuss personnel issues and maybe some legal issues. It was decided the meeting would be Thursday, April 9th.
